

20' Standard Container (20' x 8' x 8'6")

- External Dimensions: 20 Feet in Length, 8 Feet in Width, and 8 Feet & 6 Inches in Height.
- Internal Dimensions: Approximately 19 Feet & 4 Inches in Length, 7 Feet & 8 Inches in Width, and 7 Feet & 10 Inches in Height.
- Capacity: Approximately 30.20 Cubic Meters (1066 Cubic Feet) of air space & Max Payload 28.103 Ton.

40' Standard Container (40' x 8' x 8'6")

- External Dimensions: 40 Feet in Length, 8 Feet in Width, and 8 Feet & 6 Inches in Height.
- Internal Dimensions: Approximately 39 Feet & 6 Inches in Length, 7 Feet & 8 Inches in Width, and 7 Feet & 10 Inches in Height.
- Capacity: Approximately 65.98 Cubic Meters (2330 Cubic Feet) of air space & Max Payload 28.750 Ton.

40' High Cube Container (40' x 8' x 9'6")

- External Dimensions: 40 Feet in Length, 8 Feet in Width, and 9 Feet & 6 Inches in Height.
- Internal Dimensions: Approximately 39 Feet & 6 Inches in Length, 7 Feet & 8 Inches in Width, and 8 Feet & 10 Inches in Height.
- Capacity: Approximately 76.3 Cubic Meters (2694 Cubic Feet) of air space & Max Payload 28.60 Ton

40' High Cube Reefer Container (40' x 8' x 9'6")

- External Dimensions: 40 Feet in Length, 8 Feet in Width, and 9 Feet & 6 Inches in Height.
- Internal Dimensions: Approximately 38 Feet & 1/4 Inches in Length, 7 Feet & 6 Inches in Width, and 7 Feet & 11 Inches in Height.
- Capacity: Approximately 67.700 Cubic Meters (2387 Cubic Feet) of air space & Max Payload 29.580 Ton

These Dimensions & Capacities are standard for most containers used in international shipping. It's important to note that there are variations and specialized containers for specific cargo types, Open-Top (OT) Containers, Flat-Rack (FR) Containers, and Tank Containers, each with its own set of Dimensions & Capacities.
